

## Your Foundation at Work

In last years Foundation update I reminded you what Paul wrote it in 2 Corinthians 9:11, “You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.” I also thanked you for your donations to the Foundation and challenged you to consider GSPC Foundation in your estate planning. As I was in the process of writing the update for this year Pastor Jeff displayed a quote from Malachi during the service Sunday. Malachi 3:10 says, “Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the Lord Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.” The floodgates were definitely open and your generosity has been a thanksgiving to God and a blessing to Good Shepherd Presbyterian church. During 2014, gifts from memorials totaled \$174,194.95. Our balances for the Foundation accounts ending December 31, 2014 are as follows:

Permanent Endowment Fund: \$101,040.65

Capital Facilities Fund: \$109,833.00

Program, Mission and Specific Gifts Fund: \$45,879.61

Designated Endowment Funds: \$0.00

For 2014 we were grateful to distribute earnings of \$750.00 of which, \$375.00 is allocated to the Capital Facilities Fund and \$375.00 to the Program, Mission and Specific Gifts Fund. The session can then allocate these funds at any time within the guidelines of each fund. In 2013 we distributed \$600.00 and we hope to continue this trend of providing funds to serve the Lord through Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church.

On behalf of the Foundation board I would like to thank everyone who contributed to the foundation this past year with donations and gifts whether through memorials and/or direct donations. We look forward to another prosperous giving year and please keep GSPC Foundation in mind for the coming year as well as future estate planning. God bless you and your family.
